

Questions about Common Stories

Here are some examples of the kinds of questions you can ask children following reading activities, or listening to stories.

You can vary the level of difficulty of this task by selecting more or less complex stories appropriate to the child's developmental level.

Danny Champion of the World

Who were the main characters in the story?

Who thought of the plot to catch the pheasant?

What did the pheasant like to eat?

What did Danny and his dad live in?

When did Danny and his Dad go to the woods?

Where did they keep the pheasants?

Why did the pheasants fall out of the trees?

Why did they want to catch pheasants?

Rapunzel

Who wanted to lock Rapunzel in the tower?

What did the prince use to climb into the tower?

When did Rapunzel escape from the tower?

Why did Rapunzel want to escape from the tower?
