- The total amount of spend on agency nurses in the 2016/2017 tax year
- The total amount of spend on agency AHPs in the 2016/2017 tax year
- The percentage of substantive Doctor positions that are currently unfilled
- The percentage of substantive Nurse positions that are currently unfilled
- Do you have a managed service or master vendor arrangement, or an outsourced staff bank for any clinical staff groups and if so, who is/are the supplier(s)?
- Do you have a Direct Engagement supplier and if so, who?

Response:

- The total amount of agency spend on medical locums in the 2016/2017 tax year £2,222,000
- The total amount of spend on agency nurses in the 2016/2017 tax year £7,163,000
- The total amount of spend on agency AHPs in the 2016/2017 tax year £2,251,000

- The percentage of substantive Doctor positions that are currently unfilled 16.2%
- The percentage of substantive Nurse positions that are currently unfilled 27.7%
