Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act

Thank you for your email of 18 October, making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust is able to provide the information below in response:

Request:

1. How many reported incidents of physical assaults against lone workers (ie; district nurses; community nurses; mental health nurses; health visitors etc) have been recorded at your organisation in each of the last three years? If you are able to make clear how many of the assaults had medical factors involved, that would be helpful.*

2. If possible, please categorise the types of assaults these included (For eg; punching; kicking; assault with a weapon; sexual assault etc)

3. Has your organisation been made aware of any reports of stalking or harassment against any lone workers in this time period (2015-17)?

4. How many of the physical assaults have resulted in legal prosecutions against the perpetrator?

5. Please attach a copy of your lone worker policy and explain whether lone workers receive a lone worker device, personal alarm or other safety device?

Categories are given as recorded on our incident reporting system. The second table relates to their query on medical factors.

Please note that this includes all incidents of assault that were *not* recorded as occurring on an inpatient ward. Data may, therefore, include assaults that were not on lone workers as it would depend on where the incident took place.

Lone workers are not routinely issued with lone worker devices, although they are available through local managers/procurement following a local risk assessment. Other forms of alarm or safety devices may also be issued locally dependent on perceived risk but there is no Trust-wide requirement to issue to all lone workers.

If you are unhappy with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to me and I will ensure the decision is reviewed. The Trust will consider undertaking a review if requested to do so within 40 working days of the date the response is received by the applicant, and will apply discretion if a longer period of time has passed.

Should you wish to make a complaint as a result of the outcome of such a review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision.

Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the Trust for FoI Act matters.
