## **Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act**

Thank you for your email of 7 December, making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust can provide the information below in response:

## Request:

Can you please tell me how much OHNHSFT pays the Orders of St John for the annual rental and other services at Chipping Norton Community Hospital

Please break down the information into any sub divisions ie Physiotherapy, other day hospital facilities, other rooms or space rented for such things as district nurse office base and any site rental costs. The total should cover all charges from OoSJ to OHNHSFT

If for example Physiotherapy is no longer an OH contract please give the figures for the last full year and the amount for the part year when the contract ended

Can you also please tell me how much was paid for the Intermediate Care Ward in the last full year OH had the contract

I would like all figures broken down into the various elements eg building rental, equipment rental and other services (such as catering, cleaning maintenance etc)

## Response:

The Trust lease is with NHSPS (NHS Property Services) and not with the Orders of St John, and advise contacting NHSPS who may hold this information.

With respect to the Intermediate Care Ward we advise contacting Oxfordshire CCG, who may hold this information.

Should you wish to make a complaint as a result of the outcome of such a review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision.

Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the Trust for FoI Act matters.
