Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act

Thank you for your email of 19 December, making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust can provide the information below in response:

Request and Response:

We would like to request the following information from Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust regarding all Tier 3 Adult Drug Treatment Services (Drug and Alcohol Services and Prisons), that can prescribe Opioid Substitution Therapy (OST) drug treatment in your locality.

The Trust hold no information in relation to this request, and advise that the request is made to NHS England (for prisons) and Oxfordshire CCG and Buckinghamshire CCG for substance misuse services.

If you are unhappy with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to me and I will ensure the decision is reviewed. The Trust will consider undertaking a review if requested to do so within 40 working days of the date the response is received by the applicant, and will apply discretion if a longer period of time has passed.

Should you wish to make a complaint as a result of the outcome of such a review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision.

Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the Trust for FoI Act matters.
