

Recent Evidence from Primary Care

Optimising early detection of degenerative cervical myelopathy: a systematic review of quantitative screening tools for primary care

The findings suggest that while questionnaires and conventional physical performance tests offer accessible and effective initial screening options, sensor-assisted tests may provide higher diagnostic accuracy, although with limitations related to equipment accessibility and learning curve.

Digital technologies to support self-management of COPD: early value assessment

Seven digital technologies to support self-management of COPD in adults can be used in the NHS during the evidence generation period. The technologies are: • Active+me REMOTE • Clinitouch • COPDhub • COPDPredict • Lenus COPD Support Service • Luscii • myCOPD.
