#### **Recent Evidence from Primary Care**

Clinical and cost-effectiveness of paramedics working in general practice: a mixed-methods realist evaluation

We found little evidence that paramedics in general practice care led to substantial spillover effects via increased reconsultations, prescriptions, secondary care referrals or unplanned hospital admission costs.

<u>Diabetes self-management education and support delivered by mobile health (mHealth) interventions for adults</u> with type 2 diabetes—A systematic review and meta-analysis

mHealth interventions, those with education and those with support appear to have clinically relevant effects on HbA1c compared to Usual Care and APC(placebo) in adults with type 2diabetes
