



Directions from the front of the main hospital

Follow the footpath around to the right-hand side of the Warneford hospital. Pass Wintle Ward on your left & Cotswold House on your right. Pass through the gap in the stone wall on the right and continue along the footpath until you reach the Chapel on your left. Turn left after the Chapel and walk straight ahead – the May Davidson Building is the one-storey building with blue double doors at the end of the track. Go through the blue door, turn right and press the buzzer on the right-hand side of the door in front of you.

By Car

- The Warneford Hospital is 2.5 miles east of Oxford City centre and can be reached easily from the M40.
- From the east, turn off at junction 8 or 8a, take the A40 then the A420 to Headington centre and follow the signs to the hospitals.
- From the north, turn off at junction 9, take the A34 then the A40 northern ring road to the Marston junction (B4150), turn left onto the B4495 towards Headington and follow the signs for the hospitals.
- From the south and west, approach from the eastern ring road and B4495.

Please park in the main Warneford Hospital car park – at the front of the Hospital Site, which is accessed off Roosevelt Drive. There is limited. You may find a free parking space (for 2 hours) on Warneford Lane or Morrell Avenue.

By Bus

Oxford Bus Company Service number 4 stops in Warneford Lane at the top of Morrell Avenue. Get off just past the roundabout on Morrell Avenue/Warneford Lane and cross the road to enter through the opening in the wall. Walk straight down the driveway to the May Davidson Building.

The following services follow the same route and stop in Gypsy Lane

- Oxford Bus Company Service numbers 8 and 9
- Stagecoach Oxford Service numbers 7, U1, U5 and U10. Enter grounds of the Warneford Hospital and head towards the main reception where you will follow the signs for May Davidson leading you to the back of the Warneford Hospital.
- Please Note: U1, U5 and U10 only operate during the University semester times.

Alternatively, you use the Park and Ride from Thornhill and get off at the Gypsy Lane stop.
