FIND Service

Forensic, Intellectual and Neurodevelopmental Disabilities (FIND) Service

Finding paths through adult secure services for those with an intellectual disability, autistic spectrum disorder and/or an acquired brain injury.

The FIND Service will follow the inpatient pathway for individuals who come under CCGs in the following areas:

- ◆ Berkshire
- ◆ Dorset
- ◆ Isle of Wight
- ◆ Oxfordshire
- ◆ Southampton
- Buckinghamshire
- Hampshire
- Milton Keynes
- Portsmouth



Overview

The FIND service offers an experienced multidisciplinary team approach, including Psychiatry, Psychology, Nursing and Social Work to effectively complete access assessments and care pathway monitoring into and out of secure services

The FIND service can offer individuals and teams assessment, advice, training and information when transitioning out of secure care. Dependent upon patient need this can extend for

a short period in their new placement.

Referrals

The FIND service will take referrals from NHS England for people already diagnosed with a:

- Learning Disability
- Autism
- Acquired Brain Injury

These people will also have a forensic need due to offending or behaviours which could lead to offending.

Pathway

FIND will complete specialist access assessments to ensure that admissions to secure services are appropriate and offer an advisory role about the individual pathways.

If someone is not appropriate for admission, guidance can be provided about further options.

The FIND service will have an overview of patients detained in secure services but will mainly focus their involvement when it has been identified that they are ready for discharge to a lower level of security or the community.

Based on an assessment of need the FIND service will work with the case manager working with the patient, facilitating discharge to the least restrictive environment.

Links to other services

Patients linking to the FIND service will continue to have:

- involvement of an NHS England case manager who will lead on regular care and treatment reviews (CTRs)
- involvement of NHS England and CCGs to commission future placements.
- an identified care co-ordinator and care manager from their local area.
