The FIND service will work with people with a learning disability.



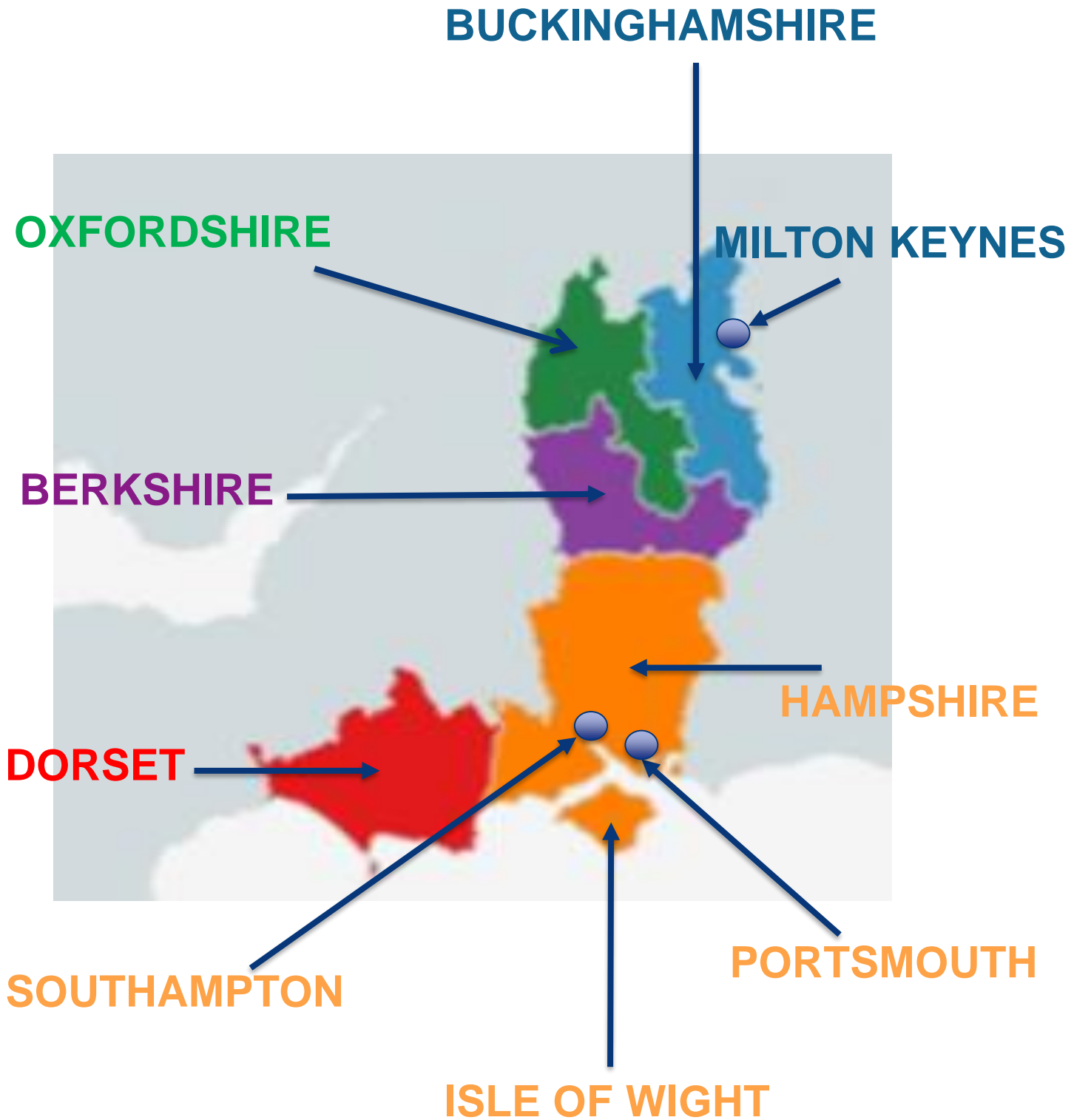
The FIND service will work with people with autism.



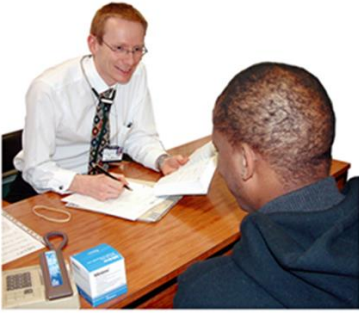
The FIND service will work with people who have had a serious brain injury.

The FIND service will work with people when they are ready to move to a new placement.

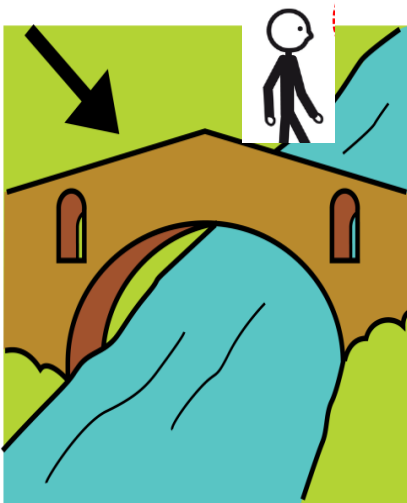
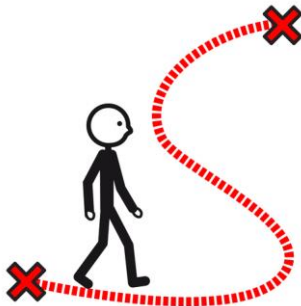


They will assess what people need in their next placement.
