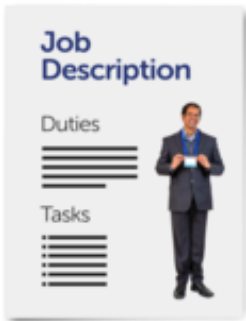




Rachel Miller Experience and Involvement Lead for people with Learning Disabilities Learning Disabilities
