What is the Journey to Outstanding Programme?

Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust has embarked on a journey to improve the experience, quality and outcomes of the care we deliver across our services. The Journey to Outstanding programme is a two year journey to support teams to realize their full potential through self-assessment and peer reviews.

How can I be involved?

Our clinical teams have completed a Care Quality Commission (CQC) self-assessment to identify strengths and areas for improvement. To support their efforts towards improvement, we are looking for people with a lived experience to visit the teams to provide them with feedback and recommendations.

What is the time commitment?

Prior to the visits, there will be a workshop to prepare for the Peer Reviews. The workshops will take 1.5 hours. The Peer Review visit will take 3.5 hours. In total the time commitment will be 5 hours - equivalent to half a day.
