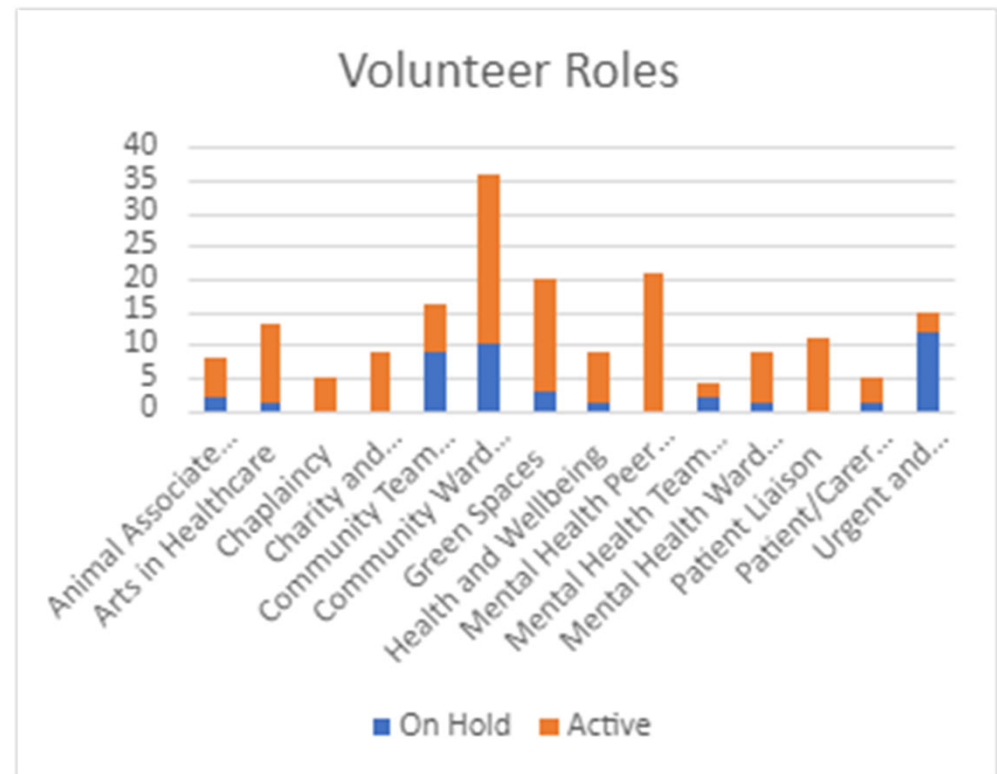

Recent Projects – Volunteering Focus

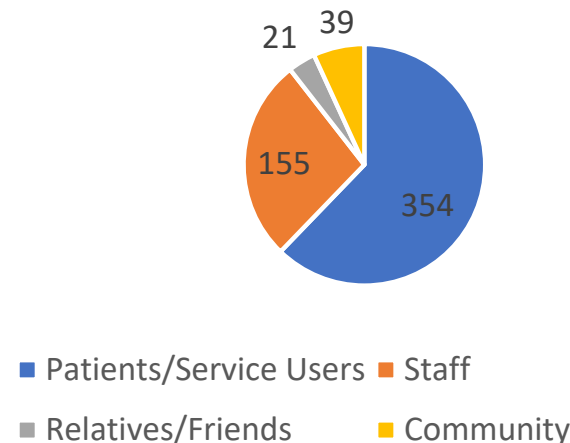
- Roles open to recruitment – Ketamine Clinic Support, Warneford; Green Spaces support, various wards; Patient Experience Support, Adult Mental Health; Forensic Recovery College Support; PAT Volunteer, Highfield; PDPS Support
- Volunteer to Career project underway (funding through HEE) with monthly steering groups – pilot area in ED services in Wiltshire – multiple volunteers involved and first individual successful in application to join CAMHs
- Development discussions underway with Research and Development (CRF), CAMHS, Carer Support and Urgent Care
- Widening of the HEE accredited learning programme for volunteers to new volunteers
- New volunteer data management system being introduced to bring Trust in line with other NHS Volunteering programmes – Assemble
- Waiting Well project underway with Adult ED services – volunteers signposting and supporting patients waiting for treatment
- Development of relationship with Oxford Brookes to increase awareness of volunteering through their new portal
- Current number of volunteers and scope of roles –
 - 181 Volunteers (Full review of inactive volunteers being undertaken)



Recent Projects – Oxford Health Arts Focus

- Creative Connections Didcot project underway (supported through Lottery funding)
- EIS patient sessions underway with the Pitt Rivers Museum, Oxford (through GLAM)
- Green Spaces project review and introduction of new Green Spaces Coordinator post under discussion
- Wantage Arts project progressing with school and care home sessions (alongside Vale and Downlands Museum)
- PICU Development support – Appeal fundraising support, art projects to enhance the space including future planning for workshops/training
- Art workshop at Recovery and Renewal session in March
- A Walk through Nature (Creative Connections) book final review – for distribution across older adult wards
- Increased interest in volunteering to support arts within healthcare – applicants both for supporting sessions and active delivery (art, music and dance)
- Full review of intranet and internet pages undertaken with Communications to increase awareness
- AIM project to evaluate art impact on patient mood ongoing with report expected in April (with Oxford University)
- 64 art sessions held since 1 Jan –
