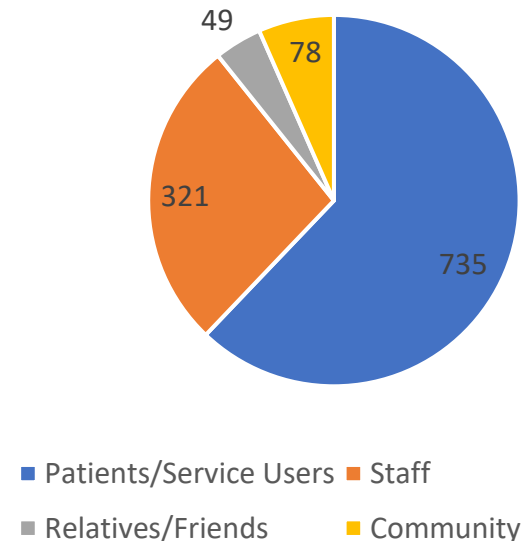
Recent Projects – Oxford Health Charity

- Support for the Staff Awards – prizes, thank you gifts for attendees, decorations, prize draw and attendance to support the event
- Attendance at the NHS Charities Together Conference
- Event planning for summer fundraising events underway – with particular focus on increasing numbers of community fundraisers
- Donorfy system now in use and number of charity contacts increased to 343 and gift income per month monitoring now available
- Harlequin system now in use (with some final data issues being resolved) and business objects access now in place for realtime data review
- Ongoing high levels of funding requests being received (34 received since 1 April 2023)
- Support of up to £200 per ward provided for Coronation Weekend activities
- Planning and promotion for NHS Big Tea events in place with teams being encouraged to host their own events
- Potential appeal discussions underway with Wallingford for their End of Life suite, in partnership with the League of Friends

Recent Projects – Oxford Health Arts Focus

- Representation at BRC day Oxford on 10 May – focussed on research project on the impact of arts on health
- OHAP filming started – first showing due at NPAG conference
- College students from the ‘living well course’ started volunteering to support arts and engagement at Witney Community Hospital
