Recent Projects – Oxford Health Charity

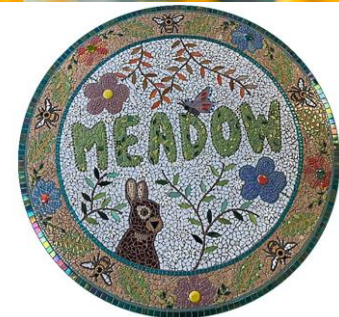

- Celebrating and engaging with our volunteers and supervisors to recognise Volunteers week
- Development discussions with Yellow Submarine and Abingdon & Witney College to see how we can best support their students in volunteering roles
- In depth discussion with the Community hospitals to identify a definitive list of tasks and ensure there is local supervision at each site
- Meeting held with Bicester League of Friends to discuss volunteering opportunities at the C.H.
- Additional staff member involved with Volunteer to Career programme in Marlborough
- Potential new roles under discussion in Salisbury, Aylesbury and in support of fundraising

Recent Projects – Oxford Health Arts Partnership



- Dance sessions provided at 'Have a Go!' week events with the Learning Disabilities Service
- The artwork for the PICU is progressing - young people have completed a mosaic sign for the front of the building and mosaicist Becky Paton has completed a beautiful butterfly design for the garden
- A second mosaic of a moth will be finished by the end of July ready for the opening.
- Artist Rachel Barbaresi is working on a large-scale design for the reception and main corridor, incorporating the work of young people from Highfield
- Staff team building art sessions with two artist created over 25 canvases to be hung in staff areas and be made in to bespoke artwork for each room
