

Telling Stories // Aged 0 -2



Speak to your baby face to face so they can watch your facial expression. Make sure your baby is close enough to see your face clearly (for very young babies this is around 20cm away).

Talk to your baby about the simple events of the day using interesting intonation (changing the pitch of your voice).





Repeat phrases linking to the event of the day e.g. "We went to see Granny today and we played in the garden....We went to see granny didn't we? We had lots of fun."

Look out for signs that your toddler is learning to play imaginatively, this begins with including toys within the child's everyday activities e.g pretending to feed/dress a doll or teddy; drive a toy car etc.
