Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act

Thank you for your email of 26 November making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust is able to provide the information below in response:

Request:

Could you inform us of whether service provision is available for children who stammer (between ages three and eighteen) through Oxford Health NHS Trust? This includes information about the structure of the Speech & Language Therapy service commissioned within your Trust and whether there are specialist services available specifically to children who stammer, e.g. dysfluency clinics. Where possible, please include details relating to any specified criteria for accessing this service, i.e. age range, community/clinic based service, exclusion criteria.

Response:

- 1. Yes.
- 2. Jointly commissioned by Local Education and CCG to provide speech and language therapy support to children and young people 1 18 years of age. The service sits within the Community pathway and is organised into an Early Years (inc. foundation stage) and School Age (year 1 and above) and some specialist clinical pathways of which Dysfluency is one.
