Request for Information: Freedom of Information Act

Thank you for your email of 21st February making a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. You requested the following information and the Trust is able to provide the information below in response:

Request:

Please can you confirm that you have adopted NICE guidance NG 26 and or NICE guidance NG 116 for the treatment of PTSD If you have not adopted either can you please tell me which protocol you do follow for the treatment of PTSD

Response:

The NG116 Post traumatic Stress Disorder guidance was published in December 2019 and came to the Trust NICE Implementation Group in January 2019. A gap analysis is currently underway.

The forensic services have completed a gap analysis and have rated themselves as fully compliant with all standards relevant to their client group.

The Trust does have a detailed psychosocial response plan as part of our overall emergency planning and in a multiagency context. The psychosocial response plan describes how Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust will respond in the event of a major incident that requires a psychosocial response.

NG26 is Children's attachment: attachment in children and young people who are adopted from care, in care or at high risk of going into care and was published in 2015. Quality standard (QS 26) has been replaced by NG116. We have no data specifically in relation to a gap analysis for QS 26

If you are concerned with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to me and I will ensure the decision is reviewed. The Trust will consider undertaking a review if requested to do so within 40 working days of the date the response is received by the applicant, and will apply discretion if a longer period of time has passed.

Should you wish to make a complaint as a result of the outcome of such a review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) for a decision.

Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the Trust for FoI Act matters.
