

FOOD SUPPORT AROUND OXFORD



OMA will be taking a week off to pause, reset and reorganise between Monday March 7th and Sunday March 13th. We will not be providing any regular or emergency parcels or reheatable meals during this time. We have compiled a list of local organisations who can help with food support during this time.

Community Fridges are free to use and do not require registration. The services listed below **do not require external referrals**. and are also free to use (they may request a voluntary contribution). **Accessing any of this support will not affect receiving food parcels from OMA**.

There are also **Community Larders** available across the City, which are run by SOFEA. These require a payment of £3.50/week (10 items) or £7/week (20 items) by direct debit. You may be eligible for a grant to support you membership through the **Household Support Grant** from Oxford City Council.

There are also food support services which are free to use but **do require a referral.** You can ask for a referral via:
